There are 7 stages in total. Every stage is filled with absurd challenges, where you can score rally points. The winning team goes home with the prestigious Cali Rally Cup.

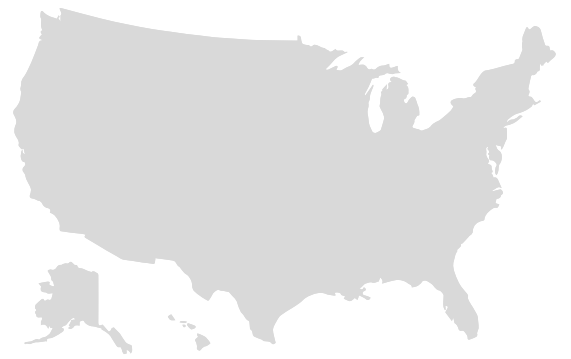

Program

Day 1: San Francisco

After landing, you're gonna head over to the rental place to pick up your car. Once you're checked in and refreshed, you're free to explore the city. Later on, you're welcome to join us for our welcome speech and a cheeky drink.

Day 2 - 3: San Francisco - Lake Tahoe

Enjoy your first day on the road. Head over to South Lake Tahoe, a gorgeous little town surrounded by beautiful nature. Lake Tahoe, also described as the "Jewel of the Sierra's", is the largest freshwater lake in North America. It's also a hotspot for action water sports.

We're staying for two nights. Our camp spot is located in the heart of the town. It lays within walking distance from the shores, shops, and cafes. Rental companies for recreational equipment are also nearby.

Day 4 - 5: Lake Tahoe - Yosemite Valley

Today we leave the lakeside and head to America's most famous park, Yosemite National Park. Yosemite Valley is one of the most majestic natural wonders in the country with plenty of woods, water and mountains to explore. Join us for a day hike, rent a bike, or visit all the famous viewpoints in the valley.

We'll camp two nights in Yosemite Lakes, about 5 miles outside the park. The campground itself is peaceful and quiet, ideal for swimming with the Tuolumne River running through the preserve.

Day 6: Yosemite Valley - Sequoia

Wake up early, hit the road and drive more inland to Sequoia National Forest. Go visit the largest tree on earth or go for a drive through a fallen tunnel log. This journey is bucket list-worthy!

Then get ready for a mighty day disco at an authentic cowboy ranch. This property is a true gem with all the space for a rad party. Every corner will have different activities. And the best part? There will be ribs & cold beers available!

Heads up, the theme is Western Cowboys!

Day 7: Sequoia - Los Angeles

Los Angeles, the city we all know from so many movies. It definitely has its perks, among never-ending sunshine, proximity to the most talented creators in art, music, and fashion and access to the best food experiences. It also means seeing a man dressed as Borat walk down Sunset Blvd and then speed off in a luxury car.

We'll stay three glorious nights at The Freehand, a premium hybrid hotel with a hipster look, and a magnificent rooftop bar with pool. Let's live the high life in downtown LA.



Day 8 - 9: Los Angeles

Day 10: Joshua Tree

In your twenties

All participants must be **21 years or older** on the date the rally starts. If you do not meet the age requirement, you will not be accepted onto The Cali Rally.



Getting to San Francisco

Flights are not included in our total package price.

San Francisco International (SFO) or Oakland (OAK) are the two closest airports to our start line. The specific address of the start of our rally will be given to you by mail when you book.

Our customer team can assist you when booking your flights.

Getting back home

When the rally comes to an end, you will have to return your car at the car rental at Las Vegas Airport. If you opted to drive back to San Francisco, you will return your car there on the given day and place. If you did not book any flights with us or did not arrange to drive back to San Francisco, you will have to arrange your departure back home.

Do keep in mind that when the rally ends, you're still in Las Vegas. A transfer flight is recommended to get back to the start point

Rental Cars

You can rent a car with one of our partners. No worries, just select your type of car when booking and TCR sorts out the rest.

Our partner has a wide range of different vehicles available. From compact cars and pick up trucks to big SUVs and roaring American muscle cars.

Documents

A PASSPORT

A passport, of course, is the number one requirement to travel internationally. We're talking about an international travel pass here. You know, the fancy book form one where they give you stamps.

ESTA

An 'Electronic System Travel Authorization' must be requested at least 72 hours before departure. We recommend you to apply for this as quickly as possible. It costs 14 USD and must be paid for with a credit card. This is also mandatory if you are flying to another destination and only transfer in the USA.

Warning: There are many rogue websites where this permission costs you more. Only use the official website.

DRIVER'S LICENSE

We don't need to explain what a driver's license is. The only thing we need to say is that you'll need it. No need to request an international one.
